



## German External Quality Assessment Scheme

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The control material (CM) Metals in urine

for which you have requested a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) is not hazardous and/or is excluded from coverage in our regular MSDS system for one or more of the following reasons:

- 1  The CM is an article, as the word is defined by the Commission Regulation (EC) No 523/2008 of 11 June 2008 in L153/23 which does not release or otherwise result in exposure to a **hazardous chemical, under normal conditions of use.**
  
- 2  The control material has been determined to be non-hazardous according to the Commission Regulation (EC) No 523/2008 of 11 June 2008 in L153/23. The CM will not release or otherwise result in exposure to a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use. **CM is human urine and is intended for “in vitro” diagnostic use only.** The CM should be handled as recommended for any potentially infectious urine specimen.
  
- 3  The CM is an article **free of** HIV 1+2 antibodies, HBsAg, HCV antibody, Hepatitis B and C.

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
